

Te Horo School Internet Agreement

Children and parents are required to sign/authorise this Internet Agreement.

Te Horo School believes in a Digital Citizenship model for supporting safe and responsible use of the internet in teaching and learning. An important part of this is that we are able to show others what that responsible use looks like while we are using technology in our learning.

We think a good digital citizen is someone who;

- is a confident and capable user of ICT-(age appropriate)
- will use ICT for learning as well as other activities
- will think carefully about whether the information they see online is true
- will be able to speak the language of digital technologies
- understands that they may experience problems when using technology but can deal with them i.e. inform teachers or their parents
- will always use ICT to communicate with others in positive and respectful ways
- will be honest and fair in all of their actions using ICT
- will always respect people's privacy online
- Understand that access to the internet is restricted to class time or when supervised by an adult.

Logon – students from Year 3 and up will be allocated a personal logon (username and password), which should only be used by the student it is allocated to, and not shared with other students. Students in Year 4 and above will have their own email address and students in Year 5 and above can bring a device (for example Chromebook or laptop) to school as part of BYOD.

Monitoring Use – all Network and Internet use is monitored by staff to ensure compliance with this agreement and to ensure the ongoing security of the Te Horo School Network.

Because we know this is important for us all, we ask everyone, the staff and students working at the school to agree to use the internet and other technologies in a safe and responsible way by following the rules laid out in this Responsible Use Agreement.

If someone cannot agree to act responsibly, or the things that they do mean that other people are being harmed, then we reserve the right to restrict or stop them from using the internet or other technology at school.
